MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called as the 'MoU') is entered into on this the 18th day of Feb 2022 between **Govt. Pt. Shyamacharan Shukla College Dharsiwa, Raipur** herein by its **Principal**, (hereinafter referred as 'First Party', the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators, and assigns).

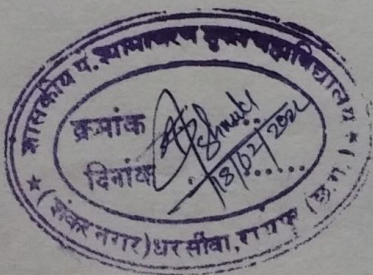
AND

CIPET: Institute of Petrochemicals Technology (IPT), Raipur herein by its **Director & Head**, (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators, and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party'):

WHEREAS:

- A) *First Party*: **Govt. Pt. Shyamacharan Shukla College Dharsiwa, Raipur**, an higher education institute established in 1989, by the government of Madhya Pradesh. The institute is affiliated to Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur (CG) since 1989. The institute is recognized by University Grants Commission under section 2(f) and 12(B). The institute caters the needs of students by providing offering various programmes in Science, Humaities and Commerce alongwith professional diploma course on PGDCA. Few departments (Mathematics, political Science, Hindi, Physics, botany, Commerce) are running Post Garaduation programmes. The institute also enhance the overall personality of the students by facilitating them with NCC, NSS, Science club



AND

B) *Second Party*: **CIPET Institute of Petrochemicals Technology (IPT) Raipur**, hereinafter called as **CIPET: IPT, Raipur**, a premier National Institute under the aegis of Ministry of Chemical and Fertilizers, Govt. of India. CIPET: IPT, Raipur has been accredited with ISO 9001:2015 QMS, ISO/IEC - 17025, ISO/IEC - 17020 certifications established to cater to Academic programme & Diploma in Plastics Technology (DPT), Diploma in Plastics Mould Technology (DPMT), Post Graduate Diploma in Plastics Processing & Testing (PGD-PPT), B. Tech in Plastics Engineering & specialized Skill Development training Programme in the field of Plastics Engineering & Technology and rendering technical / consultancy services in the area of Design, Tooling, Plastics Processing, Testing & Quality assurance of Plastics material / Product for the benefit of Plastics & allied industries.

First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide enhanced opportunities to each of them.

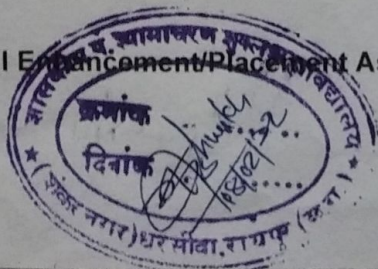
NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MoU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution. The Parties shall keep each other informed about the potential opportunities and shall share all relevant educational information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of both parties providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching/skill enhancement systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.1 **Sharing of the facilities:** Parties agree to share their important R&D facilities by signing Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) of the generated intellectual property.
- 2.2 **Joint research projects:** Parties through their faculty/employees shall explore opportunities of undertaking joint research projects and may seek research funding from external agencies. Each such research proposal shall require the approval of the respective institutions.
- 2.3 **Skill Enhancement/Placement Assistance of Students:** Parties shall actively



engage in the delivery of the training need of students of both parties to bridge the skill gap and make them industry-oriented. Both the parties will also provide the necessary support and assistance for internships and placements of students. The necessary payment should be made by each party to the others on mutual understanding basis.

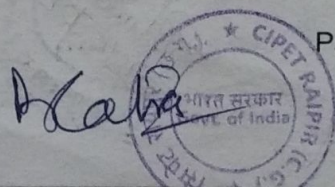
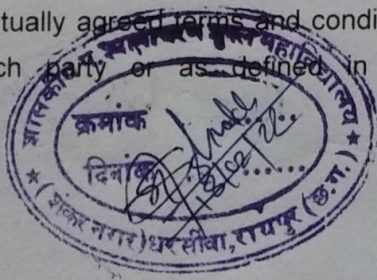
- 2.4 **Joint academic activities and events:** Parties may formulate joint academic activities such as short-term courses, training programmes, seminars, participation and access to workshops and conferences based on mutual interests and available expertise in both the institutions.
- 2.5 Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, of whatsoever nature required for offering the programmes on the terms specified herein.

CLAUSE 3: VALIDITY

- 3.1 This agreement is valid for initially for 3 years and becomes effective from the date it is signed by the parties. The partnership period may be extended by mutual consent. In case one partner wishes to terminate the MoU, intimation will have to be sent at least six months in advance. However, specific commitments made prior to such intimation shall be honored by both parties. This MoU will be identified as the parent document of any programme agreement executed between the parties. The scope of the activities under this memorandum will be determined jointly by both parties for the type of collaboration to be undertaken.

CLAUSE 4: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

- 4.1 It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MoU as an independent parties, and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name or logo in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.
- 4.2 **Intellectual Property:** This MoU seeks the sharing and spread of the intellectual properties (IP) generated through activities under this MoU on mutually agreed terms and conditions and subject to the current IP policies of each party or as defined in the collaborative projects and exchange

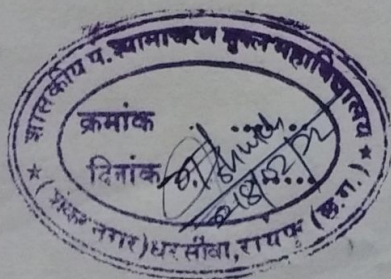


programmes. IP developed through this MoU shall be in the joint ownership of both the parties with scope to explore commercialization under mutually agreeable terms. Parties shall meet through designated representatives and seek an equitable and fair understanding to leverage the IP interest that may arise. Any such discussions will at all times strive to present a harmonious and continuing relationship between the parties. All the parties concerned with the activity under this MoU shall take reasonable steps to ensure compliance with Non-Disclosure Agreements (NDA) and other confidential agreements.

- 4.3 **Financing:** The host institute shall make local arrangements at reasonable costs for the exchange of students and faculty/employees. Travel costs shall be borne by the home institution of the visitor or as per the activity proposal. To encourage industry, connect, the parties shall strive for support from the industry as from the alumni to support such collaborations.
- 4.4 **Coordination and implementation:** A coordinating committee comprising their nominees at least two from each party would be responsible for the effective implementation of the MoU. The following coordination committee will coordinate the collaborative programmes between two parties.

The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the courts at Raipur, C.G. state.
